# Installation

## **New AFFTAC Users**

Install AFFTAC from the installation package by following the steps below:

1. Unzip the installation zip file.
2. Close all Windows applications.
3. Run setup.exe, taking note of the **installation directory**.
4. If you are an existing user, you may copy your database files (\*.adb) from the previous versions' installation folder to the new **installation directory**.

## **Existing AFFTAC Users**

If you already have AFFTAC installed, simply install the GUI by saving its .exe file over the existing one in your AFFTAC installation directory.

## **Note to All XP Users**

Please unzip the installation file manually:

1. Download the file.
2. Right click it and choose "Extract."
3. Move into the directory containing the extracted files and run setup.exe.

# Modifications

## **Public Use**

The GUI was modified so that a license key is no longer required to run the AFFTAC GUI.

# Known Bugs

## **User Can Bypass Administrative Data Requirement**

A previous requirement on the GUI was that it would not save an analysis that did not contain administrative data. But, using the new **File-Save Analysis** option, the user can bypass the warning and save it anyway. This is a non-fatal bug, but fixing it will require specifying new requirements regarding what to do when the user wants to save the **Analysis.db** file during a session but has not yet added administrative data to some analyses.
